- Dieselflex Version 1 EU-East -

1. Aim > protect against volatility of the fuel prices = compensate fluctuations

> transparency and confirmability

2. Source > Homepage of the ADAC (Allgemeiner Deutscher Automobil-Club e.V.): weekly download of the average fuel prices of the relevant transit countries

3. Principles > at the end of the month, the monthly average fuel price is drawn

> the monthly average fuel price is then compared to the **basis price** per 1 litre fuel

> the basis price per 1 litre fuel is put together of the monthly average fuel prices from December 2014 and January 2015

> per 1 Euro-Cent deviation of the monthly average fuel price from the basis price, the reimbursement is adjusted **0,25 % up or down**

> the Dieselflex is determined until max. the second week of the following month

> applies from the date of discovery to the date of discovery in the following month

4. Composition and calculation of the average fuel prices

5. Example of calculation of the new Dieselflex

Addition / discount of the reimbursement = $(monthly average price - basis price) \times 0,25\%$

Example:	V.1: EU East
Basis price	1,21 €
monthly average price, example January 2016	1,05 €
deviation to the basis price	-0,16€
Changing of the reimbursement for February 2016	-4,00%

For the transports EX / IM RO, BG, H, SK, MD, CZ, GR, PL, the reimbursement would be reduced by 4,00% in February.
